Piloting: key results and learnings

The piloting phase was an essential part of the project, involving **374 young people** and **97 professionals** across Spain, Italy, Cyprus, Slovenia, Greece, and North Macedonia. Participants engaged with the Green Up Yourself e-learning platform, developed sustainable business ideas, and participated in interactive workshops that combined practical exercises with digital learning tools.

Major findings from the pilot phase

- ✓ Increased knowledge of green jobs and entrepreneurship: over 90% of participants reported significant improvements in their understanding of sustainability-driven business models.
- ✓ High engagement with the e-learning platform: more than 95% of users found it accessible and relevant for their learning journey.
- Mentoring & networking as a game-changer: the Green Mentoring Space was identified as a crucial resource for building connections and fostering entrepreneurial growth.
- Active learning for maximum impact: workshops that incorporated interactive activities, such as team-based sustainability challenges and debates, received overwhelmingly positive feedback.
